- Commonly found on face.
- One or multiple, yellowish papules, that may reveal a central umbilication.
- White-yellowish globular structures (popcorn like appearance) surrounded by a corona of vessels at the periphery, radiating towards centre (but do not cross the centre).
- Vessels are linear, fine and blurred telangiectasia with minimal ramifications.
